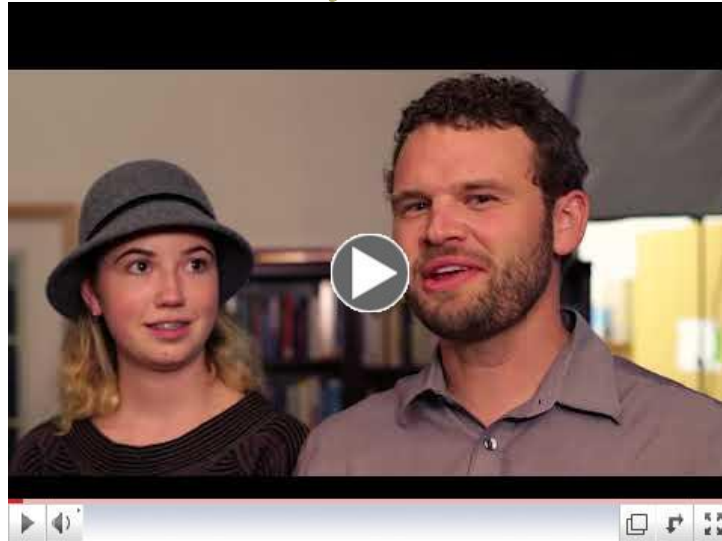

According to RAINN (Rape, Abuse & Incest National Network) 321,500 victims (age 12 or older) of rape and sexual assault accumulate each year in the United States. Every 98 seconds, another person in America is sexually assaulted. So many wounds, so much violence, so much trauma-and yet the silencing of survivors, our unwillingness as a culture to really listen and witness to each other's pain, means that trauma can inflict a double wound: crying out to be heard, only to be violated once more by those who turn away. It's time to step up collective efforts to invite stories, listen, and not turn away; to hold space for the millions of survivors in our workplaces, schools, homes and communities. Because to witness and hear is to begin the work of individual and collective healing.

Meet Our Partners

Musical Ambassadors of Peace
travels the world to build cross-cultural bridges, honor and preserve indigenous musical traditions and help heal those traumatized by war. We sent 40 drums with our Musical Ambassador to Iraqi Kurdistan to provide healing energy for Yazidi women recently liberated from 2 years of enforced sexual slavery under ISIL. The neighboring Refugee Camps were inquiring: "Where are our drums? Where is our Musical Ambassador?" We are Fund-Raising Now to send our Musical Ambassador back to Northern Iraq for musical healing for liberated Yazidi women. "I had the privilege to work with amazing Yazidi women on the second anniversary of their genocide and help heal the wounds of war." -Dilkhwa Ahmad, Musical Ambassador of Peace
